## WORLD WAR 1 RESEARCHER AUSTRALIA - APP FOR IPAD

WORLD WAR 1 RESEARCHER: AUSTRALIA includes six case studies and many research links. Although originally designed to help students and complement the Australian History curriculum, most of the hints would help anyone interested in researching or ways to share their WW1 research. Using a range of online and community resources, the app is designed to develop historical skills and share findings about family or people from the local community.


The app would assist anyone preparing a WW1 remembrance ceremony so that they can present local stories. Community organisations or researchers could also work with schools in ways suggested in the app; such as interpreting handwriting in letters in files or diaries. The key concepts of historical sources as evidence, perspectives and empathy are directly linked to local contexts.

Other features of the app include sequencing events chronologically and investigating cause and effect through aspects such as enlistment and the impact of the war on families.

## THE CREATORS


